Survey conducted September 5 through September 10, 2023. 306 likely 2023 Special Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2023 Special Election. Margin of Error is +/-5.6% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.
